

The Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program is the largest federal program providing HIV care and treatment services to people living with HIV and AIDS in the country. The Seattle Transitional Grant Area (TGA), which is comprised of King, Snohomish and Island Counties, has received funding from this program to support an integrated system of care for people living with HIV and AIDS.

Clients are eligible for Ryan White Part A-funded services if they are documented as living with HIV, are a resident of King, Snohomish or Island County or are living homeless in these counties, and are living at or below 300% of Federal Poverty Level (FPL).
