Free or low-cost flu vaccination for adults and children are available at many locations in King County during the 2020-21 flu season. Children can also get other important vaccines required for school at several free clinics. These clinics are taking careful safety precautions to prevent COVID-19. Please wear short sleeves and everyone ages 2 and older must wear face coverings.
