

# CHURCH RE-OPENING SAFETY GUIDELINES



Your actions save lives




**Clergy/staff, members, and visitors must wear a face covering before, during, and after services**

Keep your mask on even when 6+ feet away from others

## When to stay home:

If you have a sign/symptom of COVID-19: fever, cough, shortness of breath, new loss of taste or smell, body aches  
It's safest if elders and children pray at home




## Stay 6 feet / 2 meters away from others

Avoid shaking hands or hugging those outside your household  
In-home services with 5 people (plus staff) are also allowed

## Bring your own readings, do not share supplies

Avoid touching your lips to shared ritual objects  
Shared objects must be sanitized between use




## Regularly wash your hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds

Use hand sanitizer when sinks are not available  
Sanitize your hands before and after taking communion

## Take care with communion

Avoid contact with those outside your household  
Utilize single-use containers for the Eucharist



## Choirs are not permitted

Congregation may sing  
Members of congregation must keep face masks on

## Exit church right after services
