Master Installer Certificate - Prior to the Master Installer Certificate being issued, a Master Installer must supply the Department with a copy of their Washington State, Department of Labor & Industries Contractor's License. The Master Installer Certificate is for individuals who will obtain on-site sewage system installation and repair permits, and will be held responsible for all construction done under those permits.

The Master Installer exam is more detailed and requires extensive knowledge and recall of codes, rules, regulations relating to standard and alternative on-site sewage disposal systems (see the enclosed list of reference study materials for the Master Installer's Exam).

Associate Installer Certificate - For individuals who desire authorization to supervise work crews constructing or repairing onsite sewage systems. This is to be physically present during the construction phase of the installation. (See attach page for study information.)
