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DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal:

The project from Seadrunar Recycling proposes using the western portion of an existing warehouse to operate a Material Recovery Facility (MRF) for additional sorting, baling and end market loading of commingled commercial recyclable materials at 28 South Brandon Street, Seattle, WA 98134. The MRF has operated at the site since 1992 and processes clean, commingled recyclables including aluminum cans, plastic bottles, paper, and cardboard. Most of the solid waste handling activities take place inside the existing 48,000 square foot concrete and steel warehouse. Seadrunar Recycling uses a fleet of eleven trucks to deliver materials for processing at the site. This solid waste handling activity will be authorized under a MRF permit issued by the Seattle – King County Department of Public Health. This permit allows commingled recyclables to be received and sorted for end use markets in accordance with Chapter 173-350 WAC Solid Waste Handling Standards.
