

RE: Reissuance of Cedar Hills Regional Landfill Ten-Year Solid Waste Handling Permit for 2019 through 2029

Please find the enclosed Cedar Hills Regional Landfill Ten-Year Permit for Solid Waste Handling from 2019 to 2029. This permit has been prepared through intense discussions and great contributions from multiple agencies including Washington State Department of Ecology, King County Solid Waste Division, Public Health – Seattle & King County, community organizations, and members. Public Health recognizes and thanks all who participated in the preparation of this permit.

Please note that we have made appropriate and required changes to the ten-year permit by adding a newly developed landfill cell known as Area 8. The Compliance Requirements section has been moved to the beginning of the permit document in Section IV. We will continue issuing an annual permit for each consecutive year covered under this ten-year permit. The annual permit will provide us an opportunity to remove completed tasks and add the new ones that need to be completed in the current permit year.
