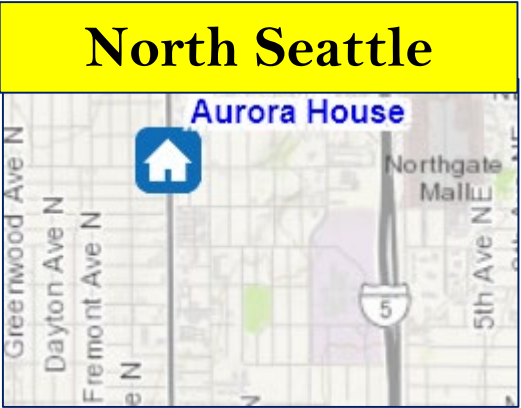
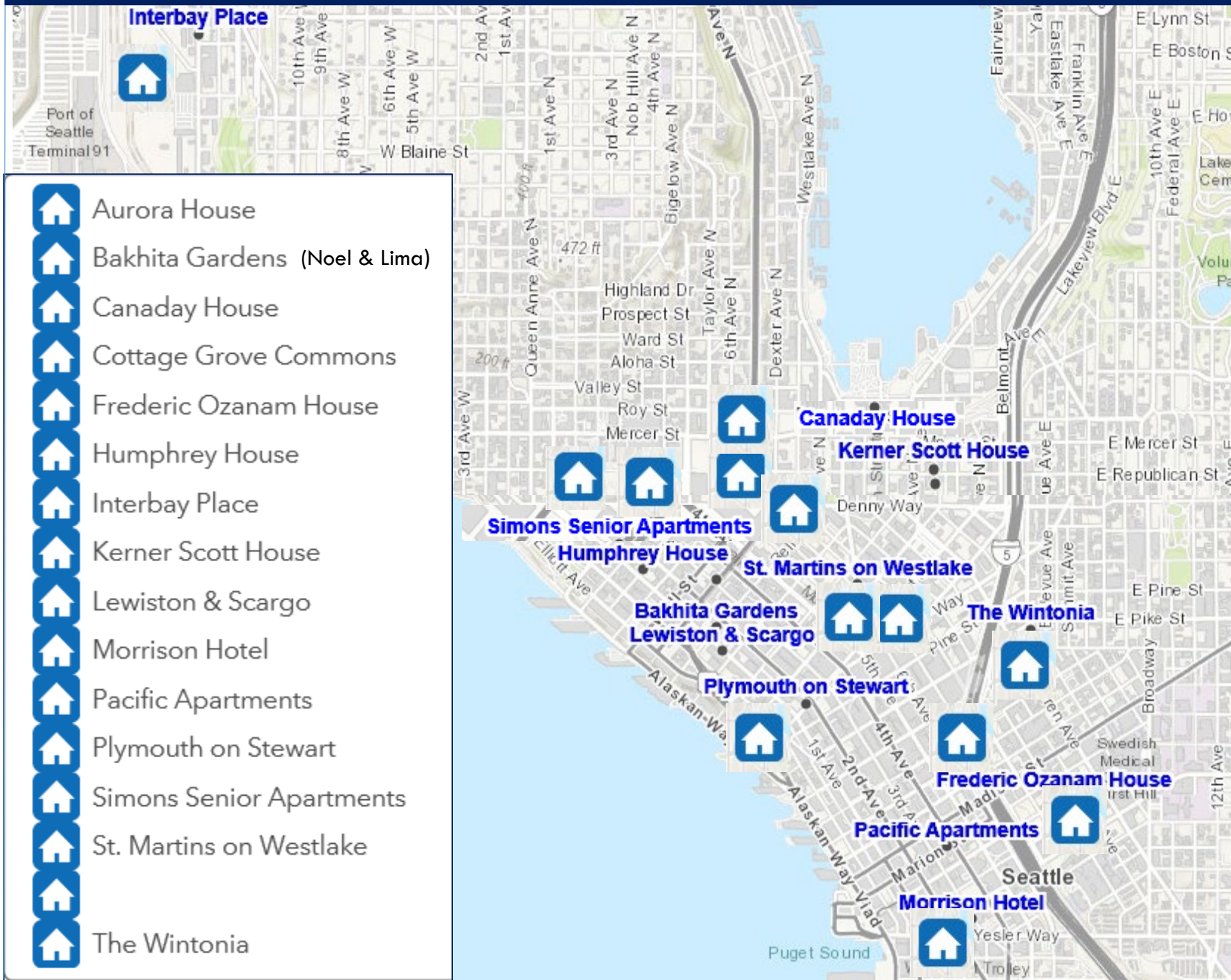
Improve quality of life and improve access to high quality health care and social supports.

Total visits: **3,333**

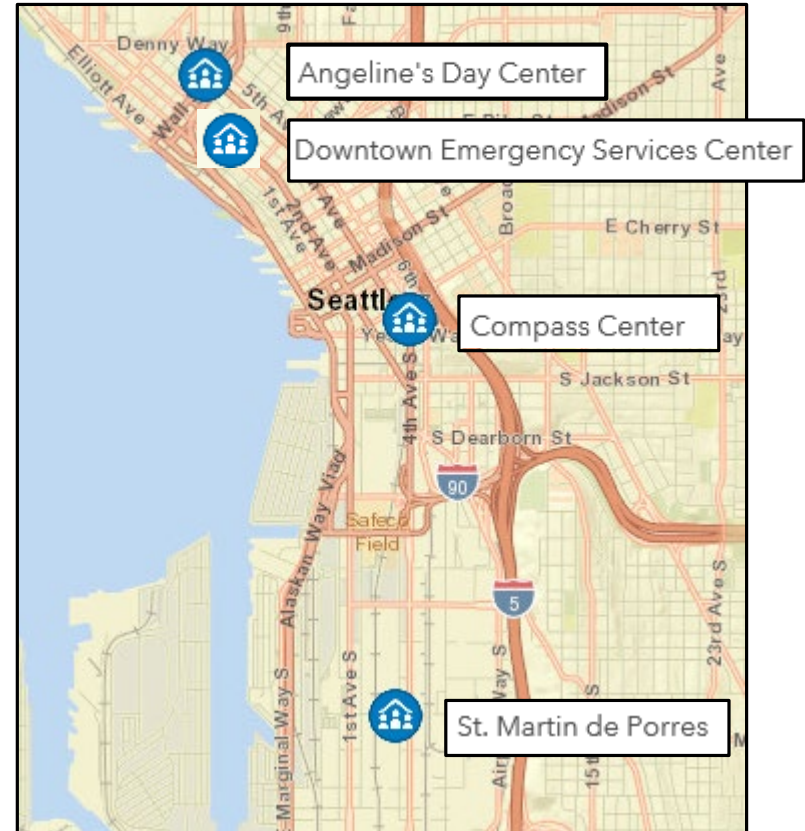
Goal:

Homeless Palliative Care Outreach Program Results Snapshot: 2018

Total patients served: 116

Total visits: 586

Goal:

Keep patients comfortable and minimize pain by addressing physical, emotional, and spiritual needs.

Service Description:

Providers go to Seattle area encampments, shelters, and emergency rooms to identify individuals coping with life threatening illnesses.

- Funding supports nurse, social worker, and health care specialist FTE.
- HCHN-funded program since 2014.
- First program of its kind in the United States.

Total visits: **707**

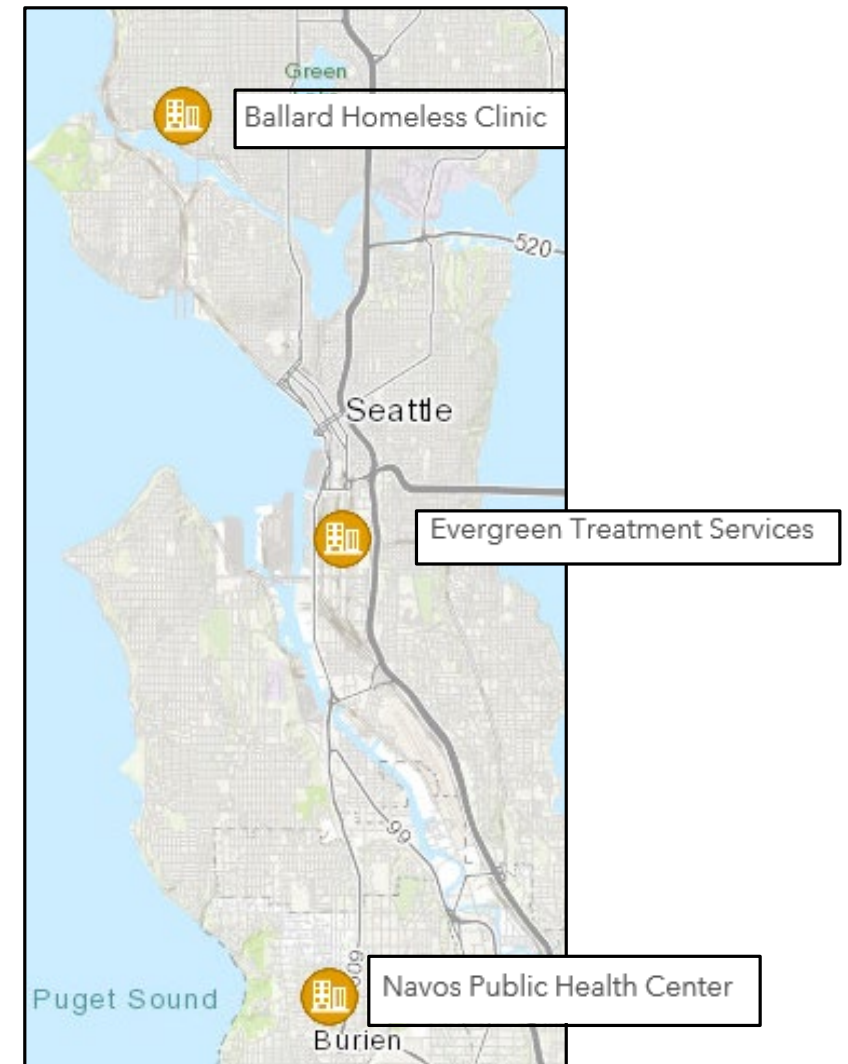
Goal:

Integrate low threshold harm reduction supports and linkages to care at 3 clinics and surrounding neighborhoods.

Service Description:

Site expansion of ETS-REACH providing outreach, case management, and behavioral health services

- Funding supports SUD Outreach case managers and administrative FTE.
- HCHN-funded program since 2015.
