- 1. Please describe your research question and why it is relevant to your community? How will this data highlight the inequities or resilience brought about by the COVID 19 pandemic? (maximum 1 page)**
  
- 2. Please outline your approach to this project (maximum 2 pages)**
  - a. Describe information/data you plan to collect. Include sources of qualitative or quantitative data.
  - b. Please describe how your organization or group is uniquely positioned within the community who will be most involved in the participatory data collection process.
  - c. Please describe what kinds of materials you might develop to share the data and stories your community will collect.
  - d. Please provide a timeline of your approach.
  
- 3. Please tell us more about your organization or group. What skills, knowledge and relationships do you bring to this project? (maximum 3 pages)**
  - a. Identify who is applying: individual, group or organization
  - b. Describe the relationship and role of each member involved.
  - c. Describe your group's approach around equity/anti-racism, participatory data collection, data analysis and dissemination.
  - d. Identify the unique knowledge, experiences, or skills, you or the group, team, or organization brings to this project?
