Replaced Peak-only Route 167 - Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

• Renton, Kennydale, Newport Hills, Clyde Hill, University District

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Between Renton and Newport Hills Park and Ride Route 167 is replaced by revised Peak-only Route 342.
- Riders destined for the University District can connect to new Frequent Route 270 and Link light rail in downtown Bellevue.
- This change will occur in 2023.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide additional service throughout the day, night, and on weekends.
- To provide travel inbound and outbound during all hours in service.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- More service outside of peak periods.
- Improves connections to transit hubs.
- Improves connections between Renton and Bellevue.

- No changes being proposed from Phase 2.
- * Frequent The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.
- * Local All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.
- * Peak-only The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
