East Link Connections Project

Revised Local Route 226 - Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

• Downtown Bellevue Transit Center, Overlake, Crossroads, Lake Hills, Bellevue College, Eastgate Park and Ride, South Bellevue Station

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Provides service between Bellevue College, Eastgate Park and Ride, and South Bellevue Link Station.
- Replaces Route 221 between the intersection of NE 8th St and 164th Ave SE and Eastgate Park and Ride.
- Provides simplified, easier to understand service between Crossroads and Eastgate.
- Revised in Phase 3 to serve NE 24th St and 164th Ave NE in Crossroads.
- Service would be removed east of 164th Ave NE on Northup Way and NE 8th Street in the Bretton Wood area. This path is within the proposed On-Demand flexible service area.
- This route would be implemented in 2023, with the opening of Redmond Technology Station.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide a more direct path through Crossroads and Lake Hills.
- To connect to more Link light rail stations.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- More transfer opportunities so riders can travel to different local and regional destinations.
- More direct paths for faster routes.
- Maintain direct service to Interlake High School and Bellevue Technology Center via NE 24th St and 164th Ave NE.

^{*} Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

^{*} Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

^{*} Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
