East Link Connections Project

Revised Frequent Route 240 – Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

• Renton, Renton Highlands, Newcastle, Newport Hills, Factoria, Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Service moves from SE Eastgate Way to SE 36th St between Factoria Blvd SE and Eastgate Park and Ride.
- New to Phase 3, Route 240 uses SE Eastgate Way (in the northbound direction), I-90 (in the southbound direction), Bellevue Way SE, and 108th Ave SE between Eastgate Park & Ride and Bellevue Transit Center. This change provides a faster connection to Link light rail at the South Bellevue Station while maintaining access to Bellevue College.
- Also new to Phase 3 is the addition of 15-minute all-day weekday frequency on Route 240.
- Provides coverage for portions of replaced Route 114.
- This change will occur in 2023.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To provide connections to community assets in Factoria and Bellevue.
- To provide connections to Link light rail.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- Improves connections between Renton Highlands and Bellevue.
- Ensures connections to hospitals and other community assets.
- Provides connections to Link light rail.
- In Phase 3, pathway between Eastgate Park and Ride and Bellevue Transit Center is revised to provide faster connections to Link light rail.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
