Revised Frequent Route 250- Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

• Avondale, Bear Creek Park and Ride, Redmond, Kirkland, Bellevue

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Starting in 2023, all trips will be extended to serve Bear Creek Park and Ride and Avondale Road.
- Route will be diverted to serve Clevland Street and NE 76th St to provide a direct connection to Downtown Redmond Station in 2024.

Why is this change being proposed?

- To connect the route with the Downtown Redmond Link Station.
- To add more frequent service to the Avondale Road corridor.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1?

• Ensure transfers are easy and seamless.

 \ast Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
