Revised Peak Only Route 342 – Phase 3

Neighborhoods Served:

• Shoreline Park and Ride, Aurora Village, Lake Forest Park, Kenmore, Bothell, Bellevue, Renton

Summary of Proposed Changes:

- Combines Route 167, which is proposed for deletion.
- Service runs both northbound and southbound during peak period (5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m).
- Extends the route to South Renton Park and Ride.
- Route stays on I-405 in Bellevue until NE 6th St to Bellevue Transit Center.
- This change will occur in 2023.

Why is this change being proposed?

- Increases speed, reduces travel time.
- Reduces service duplication.
- Connects to Link light rail.
- Provides more local connection in Renton.

How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and 2?

- Provides first-, last-mile connections to transit hubs.
- Leverages connections to Link light rail.
- Improve connections between Renton Highlands and Bellevue.

* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
