## **East Link Connections Project**

### **Revised Local Route 931- Phase 3**

#### **Neighborhoods Served:**

• UW/Cascadia Bothell, Woodinville, Cottage Lake, Duvall

#### Summary of Proposed Changes:

- New connection from downtown Duvall to Cottage Lake via NE Woodinville Duvall Rd.
- The portion of Route 931 on Avondale Rd NE from NE Woodinville Duvall Rd to NE 128<sup>th</sup> Way is replaced by new Route 222.
- The portion of Route 931 on 156<sup>th</sup> Ave NE from NE 124<sup>th</sup> Way to downtown Redmond is replaced by new Route 251.
- This proposal is unchanged between Phase 2 and Phase 3.

#### Why is this change being proposed?

• To create a direct, east-west connection between Bothell, Woodinville and Duvall.

# How does this respond to feedback Metro received in Phase 1 and Phase 2?

• Improve and add local connections.

\* Frequent - The bus comes every 15 minutes or less during peak periods and every 30 minutes or less during off-peak periods.

\* Local – All-day bus service that does not meet the standard for frequent.

\* Peak-only – The bus comes only 5-9 a.m. and 3-7 p.m. These are the times of day Metro and Sound Transit sees the most riders, usually regular commuting times, Monday through Friday.
