
You have been ordered to participate in the Community Center for Alternative Programs which is often referred to as CCAP. There are two CCAP programs: CCAP Basic and CCAP Enhanced. Persons ordered to CCAP Basic are required to report by telephone every day. Persons ordered to CCAP Enhanced are required to attend programs at the Yesler Building and may be required to submit to random drug and alcohol tests.

Orientation

All CCAP Basic and CCAP Enhanced participants are required to attend an orientation on the first day you are ordered or reinstated to CCAP. Plan to arrive at 9:00 am on the date noted on your court order. You will be assigned a Caseworker who can answer any questions you may have regarding your CCAP participation. Depending on the number of intakes that day, wait times could be up to 1-2 hours, so the sooner you arrive the sooner you can be seen by your Caseworker for your orientation. Bring all your paperwork with you (your court order and Conditions of Conduct Order).

Location

CCAP is located in the Yesler Building, 400 Yesler Way, which is approximately 2 blocks from the King County Courthouse in Seattle. See the map below. You must enter the Yesler Building using the public entrance on Terrace Avenue which is the north side of the building. Upon entry to the Yesler Building, you will go through a screening process. No drugs or weapons are allowed. Other program and facilities rules will be explained at orientation. Report to the reception area located on the first floor, Room 140.



Failure to abide by the Court Order will result in a warrant being requested for your arrest.
