Lake Forest Park – Use of Force

- 15 patrol officers
- 13,000+ calls annually
- 300+ arrests annually
- 3,800+ traffic stops annually
- Average of 6 8 Use of Force applications
- O complaints of excessive / improper force applied

LFP Body-Cam History

- Deployed 4 VIEVU Camera's in 2010
 - Voluntary Program
 - Used by only 2-3 officers consistently
 - Found value in using them
 - Added hours of administrative time (officers and records clerks)
 - Storage and duplication an issue
 - Several complaints exonerated because of video evidence

LFP Body-Cam History

- 2013 2014 No Use
- Requested from City Council to replace old technology with new in 2014 – then the Ferguson Affect.
 - The idea of added staff time with limited resources caused us to pull the item for further evaluation and input
- 2016 Trial use of Axon (Taser) Cameras
 - City Council approved testing of Taser Body-Camera systems
 - Used by several officers, very effective system
 - However would not fund additional administrative support hours
 - Duplication, redaction, and storage management Not cost effective
