## **Emergency Notification Partnership**

We need your help to spread emergency information throughout your networks!

- Sign up for alerting systems:
  - ALERT King County: www.kingcounty.gov/alert
  - AlertSeattle: alert.seattle.gov/
  - Community Communications Network (CCN): <u>www.kingcounty.gov/ccn</u>
- ALERT King County is a regional public notification system managed by King County's Emergency Management. It provides important information about potential hazards and threats in your area.
- AlertSeattle is similar, but specific to the Seattle area and managed by Seattle Emergency Management. In addition to email, voice and text alerts, it allows you to get information by social media, such as Twitter. Note that when you click to sign up, you will be redirected to the Smart911 registration page—but you'll be signing up for AlertSeattle.
- Community Communications Network (CCN), managed by Public Health, is a notification system for community leaders who agree to share information throughout their communities and report back concerns, needs or issues from community members.

## ALERT King County and AlertSeattle provide alerts in English. The CCN also sends translated information as soon as it is ready.
