Our criminal justice system doesn't address drug addiction and mental health issues.

JANE DOE – A CASE STUDY

SINCE 2014...

- Booked 25 times
- Served 43 days in County Jail
- Served 167 in SCORE
- Subject of 32 police incident reports in Burien

THE COST

\$43,000

Excluding:

- Medical treatment
- Police
- Court
- Prosecution
- Public Defense
- Other Administrative costs

JANE DOE IS KNOWN TO BURIEN POLICE

- Arresting, booking and jailing aren't working.
- Instead of progression, we see degeneration
- Burien's L.E.A.D. program, in conjunction with other systems changes, allow police and our Navigation Team to address the root causes of the most common crimes of poverty our city sees.


