Instructions

- As defined in RCW 36.102.010(9), located in King County and owned by the Washington State Public Stadium Authority. From
 and after the date that the state treasurer certifies to the Washington State Public Stadium Authority and to the county that all of
 the bonds issued to finance the stadium and exhibition center authorized under chapter 43.99N RCW are fully repaid, redeemed
 or retired, the admissions tax shall be levied and fixed at the rate of ten percent.
- · Payment and Payment Penalty if late
 - *Payment shall be made in monthly remittances on or before the fifteenth day of the month next succeeding the end of the monthly period in which the tax is collected or received and shall be accompanied by such reports as the state treasurer requires.
 - **RCW 82.32.090 If payment of any tax due on a return to be filed by a taxpayer is not received by the department of revenue by the due date, there is assessed a penalty of:
 - 9% from the 16th through the end of the month
 - 19% from the first through the end of the second month from the due date
 - 29% from the first day of the second month following the due date
 - No penalty so added may be less than five dollars
