

Get tested and treated

We provide confidential testing and treatment, and we can answer your questions about HIV and other STDs.

Get evaluated for PrEP

Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) is a pill that can prevent HIV infection. It's for HIV negative people who are at risk of becoming HIV positive through sexual activity or injecting drugs.

Get help finding HIV care

All people living with HIV in Washington State can get HIV medical care. We can connect you to the right medical provider.

No appointment needed
