## Participation Requested: Survey of Washington Veterinarians to Assess Antimicrobial Use Patterns

Dear Veterinary Professionals,

Washington Integrated Food Safety Center of Excellence (CoE) and Washington Animal Disease Diagnostic Laboratory (WADDL) are conducting a survey to assess antimicrobial use patterns and tendencies among Washington State practicing veterinarians. The results of this survey will be used to assess trends in antimicrobial use in veterinarians and assist in the development of resources for veterinary practice based upon these trends.
