

King County Superior Court Chief Civil Department Monthly Telephonic Oath of Attorney Ceremony

(If you are a new law school graduate, please attend the KCBA swearing-in ceremonies following the release of the Bar Exam results from WSBA. The monthly ceremony is not designed to administer the oath to hundreds of admittees.)

As of February 2021, Chief Civil Judge Regina Cahan will hold the Oath of Attorney Ceremony telephonically on the **2nd Thursday** of the month (except the November ceremony will be on November 4) promptly at **3:30 p.m.** The court has temporarily suspended in person walk-in ceremonies. The court will not be scheduling individual ceremonies until further notice.

1. **Call the conference line (206) 263-8114** a few minutes prior to 3:30 p.m.
2. **When prompted, dial the Conference ID: 4411261 followed by the # key.**
3. The court will roll-call the Applicants before reciting the oath. Please have your own copy of the Oath of Attorney on hand to follow along.
4. Once the oath ceremony has concluded, the judge will sign the oath of attorney form and court staff will email the completed forms to admissions@wsba.org. The court will not return the completed oath forms to individual applicants. If you wish to obtain a completed oath of attorney form for your records, please contact the WSBA a few days after the ceremony.
