DCHS expanding MIDD PME Activities

- New MIDD Eval Lead
- New mid-level evaluator
- Transitioning data manager
- Retaining initiative-level long-term evaluation
 - Annual Report
- Shifting focus to data for feedback and CQI

ENHANCING PME'S ROLE

Support from RFP to refunding decisions

- DCHS focusing on utilization of data
 - Results-Based Accountability framework
 - Data for learning, not sanctioning
 - Continuous Quality Improvement
- Highly customized approach
- Strong partnership with providers

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PME PLAN SECTIONS



Purpose Statement

or logic model depicts the hypothesized link between program activities and intended impacts or outcomes.



PME Activities

organize the collection and reporting of information about clients and/or program process. Examples include individual or aggregate-level client data, client stories and satisfaction surveys, focus groups, etc.



Performance Measures

track program activities and outcomes to improve quality and/or accountability. Ideally based on client-level data so disparities can be explored.



Reporting Requirements

specify what, when, and how data and information needs to be shared with DCHS.



COI Plan

lays out how the provider and DCHS will partner to achieve the best possible client outcomes. Examples include provider learning circles, "Plan-Do-Study-Act" cycles, etc.

ROLLING OUT PME PLANS

New MIDD RFPs and 2020 re-contracting

- Partnering with MIDD Leads for any new RFP
- Working with BHRD Contract staff to plan updates to provider manual
- Will engage more globally in 2020 during recontracting process
- More robust and useful program data by 2021

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CORE WILL LEVERAGE PME

Client Outcomes Reporting Engine (CORE)

- Reduce data processing and management burden
- Automate significant portions of routine reporting
- Provide instant feedback on performance
- Allow PME to conduct high-priority evaluations

WHAT IS CORE?

Built on Microsoft Dynamics

- Secure online portal to submit and visualize client-level data for King County DCHS contract reporting
- Back-end system to provide MIDD Leads easy access to performance data

CORE CAN...

- Validate data
 - Ensure data is complete and logical
- Explore data
 - Dashboards based on clients served and performance measures
 - Reports

DCHS IS MODERNIZING

MIDD, BSK, VSHSL, and DDECS will use CORE

- Eliminating silos between disparate data systems
 - Follow the client, not the funding streams
- Ability to meet Council's request for consolidated reporting
- SO. MUCH. DATA.


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
WHICH MIDD CONTRACTS WILL REPORT INTO CORE?


About 50 MIDD providers are impacted


- ONLY impacting providers that currently report to DCHS via CoreFTP site into the MIDD Database:

- Grantees may need to make changes to align with CORE requirements
