The goal of the King County Contracting Opportunities Program is to increase the competitiveness of certified SCS businesses in pursuing King County Funded contracts as contractors, consultants, and suppliers through a variety of incentive programs.

KING COUNTY SCS INCENTIVE PROGRAMS

Good and Services

- <u>Purchases under \$10,000</u>: Goal of 50% of purchases from SCS firms
- Purchases between \$10,000 and \$49,999: Require quotes from three companies with at least one quote from an
- <u>Purchases \$50,000+:</u> A Fair Market Range Percentage Incentive is used to provide opportunities for small businesses to be competitive on low bid procurements.
- The Small Business Accelerator: Can be used for technical services contracts and enables certain procurements to be set aside for certified SCS firms.

A&E and Professional Consulting

- Percentage of work required to go to SCS firms.
- A/E Evaluation points awarded for meeting SCS requirements.

Construction Contracts

• Percentage of the contract dollar amount required to go to SCS firms.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Business size not to exceed 50% of the SBA's current size standards (SBA Size Standards)
- Personal net worth for each owner not to exceed \$1.32M (excluding your primary residence and equity in the certifying business)
- ✓ Valid Federal Tax
 Identification Number (TIN)
 and Washington State Unified
 Business Identification (UBI)
 number
- ✓ Complete 15 hours of business training during the first year of certification
