

Secure your load

What is a secured load?

A secured load of solid waste has been securely fastened, covered, or both in a manner that will prevent the covering or any part of the load from becoming loose, detached or leaving the vehicle while the vehicle is moving.

At King County facilities, unsecured loads will be assessed a \$25 fee per King County Code 10.12.040.

It's the Law!

Item size limits

- No item longer than 8 feet
- No dense item (larger than 2'x2'x2' and weighing more than 200 pounds, such as concrete blocks and metal safes)

Vehicle length limits

Maximum combined length limit for vehicles and trailers from bumper to bumper:

- 30 feet at Algona, Cedar Falls, Houghton, Renton, and Vashon stations
- 40 feet at Bow Lake, Enumclaw, Factoria, and Shoreline stations

Fees – Effective January 1, 2019

Cleanup LIFT Discount

\$12 off the cost to dispose of garbage and each type of recyclable item, each visit. For residential customers currently enrolled in ORCA LIFT, ProviderOne, or EBT only. Just show your card at facility entrance.



Garbage

- Minimum fee: \$25.25 per entry all vehicles. Covers up to 320 lbs. (includes basic fee, surcharge, and tax)
- Per ton fee: \$151.06 (includes basic fee, surcharge, and tax)

Note: Sedans and hatchbacks pay only the minimum fee. All other vehicles will be weighed in and out, and charged for the actual weight disposed based on the per ton fee, with a minimum fee of \$25.25.

Recycling

Appliances – refrigerant type: \$30 each

Yard waste and wood (untreated)

- Minimum fee: \$12
- Per ton fee: \$75

Unsecured load

- \$25 - strictly enforced

Payment methods

- VISA or MasterCard (credit/debit)
- Cash
- Checks — payable to "KCSWD"
- Solid waste disposal cards (Skykomish only)

Guide to King County recycling and transfer facilities



Important recycling information

- 70% of what is landfilled in King County could have been reused, recycled, or composted.
- Make sure all recyclables are empty, clean, and dry. Only put items you know can be recycled in recycling bins.
- Cardboard, scrap metal, yard waste, and wood (unpainted, untreated) must be recycled at facilities offering recycling for those materials.

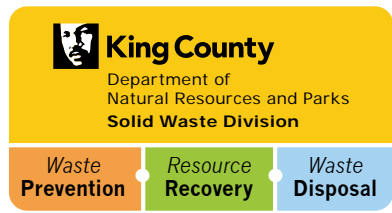

Appliances – major non-refrigerant type (dishwashers, dryers, furnaces, stoves, washers, etc.)												No fee to recycle	Limit 3 per load. Must be empty. Dishwashers made of 50% or more plastic are not accepted for recycling, but are accepted as garbage.
Appliances - small (blenders, irons, microwaves, etc.)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be at least 50% metal. Must be empty. Put in scrap metal bin.

Bicycles and bicycle parts												No fee to recycle	At Bow Lake and Shoreline: Put in bicycles bin. At Enumclaw, Factoria, Vashon: Put in scrap metal bin if made of 50% or more metal.
Cans * (aluminum, steel, tin)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be empty – no liquid or food. No plastic bags.
Cardboard (corrugated boxes)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be empty and flattened. No wax-coated, plastic-coated, or food-soiled cardboard. No Styrofoam, polystyrene, or packing peanut

Construction and demolition (C&D) debris (carpet, drywall, insulation, roofing, etc.)												Garbage fee	No dump vehicles or dump trailers (except at Vashon) unless C&D debris is an incidental part of the load (approx. 20%). No dense items (larger than 2'X2'X2' and weighing more than 200 pounds.) No items longer than 8 feet.
Dead animals up to 15 pounds												Garbage fee	Larger than 15 pounds requires waste clearance **
Dirt - uncontaminated												Garbage fee	Contaminated dirt requires waste clearance ** Will accept clean soil if less than one pickup truck load.

Fluorescent lights and other mercury-containing bulbs and tubes												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Limit of 10 bulbs/tubes per person per day. Broken bulbs must be sealed in a bag or box. No incandescent, halogen, or LED bulbs. For more recycling options visit lightrecycle.org .
Glass bottles and jars *												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be empty – no liquid or food. No plastic bags. No ceramics, glassware, mirrors, light bulbs, or windows.

Household hazardous waste (HHW) - usually labeled <i>Caution, Danger, Poison, or Warning</i> . Includes thermometers and thermostats.												No fee	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. Mattresses and box springs												Garbage fee	Limit 6 per customer, per day. More than 6 requires a waste clearance. **
Metal – scrap (lawnmowers, BBQ grills, building/electrical/plumbing parts, microwaves, small appliances with cords, bicycles, bicycle parts, etc.)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be at least 50% metal. No paint cans, sealed drums, pressurized containers, or barbed wire. Remove any fluids.

Packing peanuts												Garbage fee	Must be bagged and securely tied.
Paint – latex												Garbage fee	No liquid – must be solidified or dried out.
Paint – oil based												No fee at Factoria HHW	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. No containers larger than 5 gallons. Households limited to 50 gallons a day. Commercial loads visit hazwastehelp.org
Paper *												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Food boxes must be empty. No food-soiled paper. No plastic bags. No shredded paper as of Feb. 1, 2019.
Plastic containers * (bottles, cups, jugs, tubs, etc.)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be empty – no liquid or food. No toxic product containers. No plastic bags.
Plastic wrap (bubble, pallet, shrink, stretch wrap; plastic "air" pillows) and plastic bags (bread, dry cleaner, grocery, newspaper, produce, retail)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Must be clean, dry, and empty. No food, liquid, candy or chip bags, black trash bags, biodegradable or compostable bags, prewashed salad mix bags, labels, or tape. No commercial loads; residential only.

Propane tanks and pressurized containers												No fee	Accepted at Factoria HHW only. 8 gallon limit.
Sharps – home-generated only (needles, syringes, etc.)												No fee	Accepted in designated bin. Must be in a puncture resistant, leak proof container labeled "sharps" with a secured lid. Commercially generated sharps accepted at Vashon with a waste clearance. ** Visit kingcounty.gov/WhatDoDoWith for more information.
Televisions	NOT ACCEPTED											Contact 1-800-732-9253, ecyclewashington.org for free recycling options	
Textiles (clothing, fabric, shoes, curtains, linens, pillows, stuffed animals, throw rugs, etc.)												No fee to recycle	To recycle: Reusable and torn, worn, stained items accepted. Single shoes OK. No carpet or items that are wet, mildewed or soiled with hazardous materials.
Tires												Garbage fee	Limit 4 per customer. No large truck tires.
Wood – treated, painted, stained (railroad ties, etc.)												Garbage fee	No dump trucks or dump trailers. No items longer than 8 feet. No commercial loads of railroad ties.
Wood – unpainted, unstained, untreated (crates, lumber, pallets, particle board, plywood)												Reduced fee if recycled	To recycle: No yard waste such as branches, stumps or wood rounds. No sod, soil, rocks, or plastic bags. No metal hinges or latches. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and wood will be charged the garbage fee.
Yard waste (branches, brush, grass, leaves, stumps, wood rounds, etc.)												Reduced fee if recycled	To recycle: No sod, soil, rocks, or plastic bags. No items longer than 8 feet. Mixed loads of garbage and yard waste will be charged the garbage fee.

* Place these materials together in "Recyclable Materials" bin.

** May be accepted at Cedar Hills Regional Landfill with prior approval known as a "waste clearance." Fees apply. Call 206-477-4466.
