### **Waste Reduction and Recycling (Level One)**

- Hilltop Elementary increased its recycling rate from 33 percent to 58 percent.
- The school created a student Green Team made up of 21 fourth-grade students and one second-grade student.
- The school hosted the King County "Going Green Together" assembly, classroom workshops, and Recicla Mas workshops to introduce students to waste reduction and recycling practices.
- To kick-off milk carton recycling in its lunchroom, Hilltop conducted a Milk Carton Recycling Week in January 2018. School-wide announcements were made and student monitors helped other students sort at each lunch.
- Throughout the school year announcements were made to remind students and staff members about Green Team meetings and actions.
