BELLEVUE FORCE MAIN INSTALLATION PROJECT

Jan. 3, 2008 Project Update

King County's contractor connected the new force main to the regional wastewater conveyance pipe at the Lake Hills Connector site and restored the work site. Lake Hills Connector's exterior northbound lane and sidewalk returned to service on Dec. 19. Repaving work on Lake Hills Connector will occur later. The sound wall at the Bellevue Pump Station site was removed. Surveyors will continue monitoring along the pipeline path through the end of the project.

Work hours will generally continue to be 7 a.m. - 6 p.m. weekdays, and 9 a.m. - 6 p.m. on Saturdays.

Site Specific Work Schedule Jan. 3 - Jan 24

(Please note: this schedule is the contractor's best estimate on the timing of activities and is subject to change)

Bellevue Pump Station Work Site

(Southeast Sixth Street, west of 102nd Avenue)

- Force main pipe connected to the Bellevue Pump Station.
- Monitoring along western pipeline segment between pump station and Bellevue Club/Brookside Office Building site.
- Site restoration

Bellevue Club/Brookside Office Building Work Site

(Southeast Sixth Street, between 112th and 114th Avenues Southeast)

- Pipe installed between force main's eastern and western drilled segments
- Pipe testing
- Monitoring along western pipeline segment between Bellevue Pump Station and Bellevue Club/Brookside Office Building site.

Lake Hills Connector Work Site

(Westbound lane of Lake Hills Connector & corner of Southeast Fifth Street and 118th Avenue Southeast)

- No work scheduled
