

48-Hour Notice of Closed Circuit Television Inspection (CCTV)

Within the next 48 hours King County inspection crews will be conducting closed circuit television inspection of the culvert located on 102nd Avenue SE

The King County Wastewater Treatment Division (WTD), in coordination with the City of Bellevue, will be inspecting drainage facilities under a portion of 102nd Avenue SE including the box culvert conveying Meydenbauer Creek that is located near your property at 410 102nd Ave SE.

The inspection crew will use a remote camera and radio transmitter to view the inside condition of the culvert. This activity will not impact travel along 102nd Ave and should take less than one hour to complete.
