Closure of SE 3rd Street between 102nd Avenue SE and Bellevue Way SE

Bellevue Influent Trunk Project

Closure of SE 3rd Street

In early November, King County's contractor will progress with pipeline work on SE 3rd Street between 102nd Avenue SE and Bellevue Way SE. Crews will start near 102nd Avenue SE and move east toward Bellevue Way SE. The nature of this work will require King County to close SE 3rd Street to through traffic. Local access will be maintained (cars will enter from either 102nd Avenue SE, or Bellevue Way SE depending on the location of work and the building). Those with work occurring directly in front of their driveways (limiting access) will be provided 48 hours notice in advance of work. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.

Parking restrictions will be in place on the south side of SE 3rd Street. No parking signs will be posted 48 hours in advance of restrictions.

Crews anticipate that this work on SE 3rd Street between 102nd Avenue SE and Bellevue Way SE will last for approximately six weeks. Crews may need to return in late February to complete final items and restoration.

What you can expect:

- Work hours will occur between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday (when necessary).
- Closure of SE 3rd Street between 102nd Avenue SE and Bellevue Way SE; local access maintained.
- Restricted parking on SE 3rd Street.
- One-way northbound traffic on 102nd Avenue SE.
- Noise and activity typical of construction: work crews, heavy machinery, dust, and trucks.
- Traffic control and flaggers onsite daily to manage traffic flow and local access.
- Emergency vehicle access maintained at all times and coordination with other public services.
