Dewatering to Start on 102nd Ave. SE

Bellevue Influent Trunk

Dewatering

Starting over the next couple of weeks, crews will be setting up a dewatering system on the southern portion of 102nd Avenue SE, on the west side of the roadway. Setup of the system will temporarily impact access to driveways in this area and create additional noise. Dewatering will temporarily control the groundwater to allow crews to complete work below ground. Groundwater will be pumped out of the immediate work area on a continuous basis (24 hours a day) into a dewatering settlement tank. The tank removes debris and releases the water into the King County sanitary sewer system and storm water system. Residents should expect continuous noise associated with the pumps.

Upcoming pipeline work

At the end of February, the contractor will start laying pipeline on the southern half of 102nd Avenue SE (between SE 3rd Street and SE 6th Street), on the east side of the roadway. This work will include additional traffic impacts and increased noise and activity in the area.

Pipeline work has been completed on the northern portion of the roadway and on SE 3rd Street. A separate crew will be completing restoration of the area in the following weeks.

What you can expect:

- Work hours between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Friday, and 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday (when necessary).
- Restricted parking on 102nd Avenue SE.
- One-way traffic northbound on 102nd Avenue Southeast.
- Door hanger notifications when driveway impacts are anticipated.
- Temporary access delays when work is occurring directly in front of driveways.
- Plan for extra travel time when driving through the work zone.
- Additional noise and activity typical of construction: work crews, heavy machinery, dust, and trucks.
- Traffic control and flaggers onsite daily to manage traffic flow, pedestrian crossings, and local access.
