Project Nearing Completion

**Major construction is now complete; property restoration continues
Bellevue Influent Trunk**

Major Construction Complete

Last month, crews completed major construction on the Bellevue Influent Trunk sewer project. Recent work included sawcutting and preliminary paving, completion of curbs, gutters and sidewalks, permanent side sewer connections and the final connection to the Bellevue Pump Station.

Property Restoration

Crews continue to complete private property restoration throughout the project area. Thank you to the property owners, managers, tenants who have notified us of property damage. Restoration includes repairing damaged irrigation lines, removing temporary paving, planting trees and landscaping and other miscellaneous items. Once property restoration is complete, the contractor will be working with the property owners, or their representatives, to complete a construction restoration acceptance form.

Final Roadway Paving

In May, crews completed the preliminary layer of asphalt on 102nd Avenue SE between SE 6th Street and SE 3rd Street, on SE 3rd Street between 101st Avenue SE and 102nd Avenue SE and on a portion of SE 6th Street near the 102nd Avenue SE. This work supports the final paving overlay that will be completed as part of the City of Bellevue's summer paving projects. Bellevue anticipates the final overlay will be scheduled in August.
