



Queen Anne Site Project Update – May 11, 2015

Site preparation activities increase

King County’s contractor will be working on the following tasks at the Queen Anne (south) project site in May:

- Fencing the project area
- Installing erosion control
- Establishing site entrances
- Providing temporary power to the site
- Dewatering well drilling
- Set up of water treatment tanks

Some traffic detours will be required later this summer. King County will provide more information to project neighbors before detours occur.

What to expect during construction

- Work from 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on weekdays, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturdays (as needed)
- Increased noise and activity at site
- More trucks on nearby roads

The following areas remain open:

- West Ewing Mini Park
- The dock near the King County Environmental Labs
- Nearby business delivery areas
