Fremont Site Project Update

September 9, 2015

2nd Ave NW reopens as pipe work continues in Fremont Canal Park

King County's Fremont Siphon Replacement Project contractor finished upgrading a City of Seattle water pipe that runs directly under 2nd Ave. The work had closed access to NW Canal St from 2nd Ave NW for a few weeks. 2nd Ave NW reopened on September 9.

2nd Ave NW will remain open through early October. NW Canal St residents should use 2nd Ave NW to access NW Canal St during the upcoming Fremont Oktoberfest (September 18-20).

The contractor continues to work to replace a City of Seattle storm drain in Fremont Canal Park. Burke-Gilman Trail users should follow the trail detour north and south of the normal trail to get around the work area safely. (See map)

What to expect

- Work from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. weekdays
- Increased noise and activity in Fremont Canal Park
- Burke-Gilman Trail shifted south just east of 2nd Ave NW
- Flaggers directing trail traffic around the work areas
- Some short delays on Burke-Gilman Trail while equipment crosses the trail between work areas
- Trail users should access the trail and Fremont Canal Park from 3rd Ave NW or 1st Ave NW
- More trucks on nearby roads
