Queen Anne Site Project Update

March 16, 2016

W Ewing Alley closed between 3rd Avenue W and 6th Avenue W until fall

In late March, King County's contractor for the Fremont Siphon Replacement project will start building the structure that will connect the new siphons to the existing sewer under the W Ewing Alley. **W Ewing Alley will be closed to through traffic between 3rd Ave W and 6th Ave W beginning Friday, March 18 and will remain closed until the fall.**

Vehicle traffic will be detoured off of W Ewing Alley onto W Ewing St or W Nickerson St. The Ship Canal Trail will remain open.

Along with the closure, this work will increase noise and activity around the project site. The contractor will begin by installing shoring for excavation of the new connecting structure.

What to expect

- W Ewing Alley closed to through traffic between 3rd Ave W and 6th Ave W
- Vehicle traffic routed off of W Ewing Alley onto W Ewing St or W Nickerson St
- The Ship Canal Trail will remain open to bicycle and pedestrian traffic
- Flaggers and signage to help safely direct traffic to detour route
- Increased noise and activity from pipe installation activities
