



Project Update - August 22, 2016

Hello from King County—

King County's contractor will begin installing a new 9-foot-diameter pipe under N.W. Canal Street in Fremont on Tuesday, August 23. The pipe will connect the new siphons to the existing sewer system.

A large crane will need to be moved on to the Burke-Gilman Trail at times to install the pipe near 2nd Ave. N.W. in Fremont. Trail users should follow directions from flaggers on site to pass safely through the work area.

What to expect:

- Burke-Gilman Trail blocked for brief periods near 2nd Ave. N.W. on Tuesday, August 23
- Brief delays for trail users near 2nd Ave. N.W. and N.W. Canal St.
- Flaggers on site to guide trail users around the work area safely
- Bicyclists may be directed to slow down and/or dismount
- No disruption to normal sewer service



The Burke-Gilman Trail will be closed occasionally while a crane moves a 9-foot diameter pipe into place under N.W. Canal St. in Fremont.
