Queen Anne Site Project Update

Crews finish Queen Anne connection structure - West Ewing Alley reopens week of Oct. 3

King County’s contractor for the Fremont Siphon Replacement project will reopen the West Ewing Alley between 3rd Ave. W and 6th Ave. W during the week of October 3. Crews completed work on the structure that will connect the new siphons to the existing sewer under the W Ewing Alley.

The contractor will install temporary paving to restore W Ewing Alley until final paving restoration can be complete. W Ewing Alley will be fully restored as part of project closeout in 2017. We will share more information about the final restoration after it is scheduled.

What to expect

- W Ewing Alley open to traffic with temporary paving
- W Ewing St and Ship Canal Trail remain open to all normal uses
