West Ewing Alley closed for shoring removal on October 10

King County's contractor has finished building the structure connecting the new siphons to the existing sewer under the W Ewing Alley. The alley will be closed starting the week of Oct. 10 while crews remove shoring from the project area. The alley will reopen by the end of October.

Shoring removal can be more intense than normal construction activities. You may notice more noise and vibration while the work occurs.

King County monitors noise and vibration levels to protect public safety.

- Periods of increased noise and vibration
- W Ewing St and Ship Canal Trail remain open
