Queen Anne Site Project Update

Jan. 18, 2017

Ship Canal Trail closed Jan. 19 and 20 for repaving

The contractor began restoring the project's Queen Anne construction area this week. To finish restoration, the contractor will repave the Ship Canal Trail near its intersection with 3rd Avenue N.W. The trail will close while work occurs on Thursday, Jan. 19 and Friday, Jan. 20.

What to expect

- Trail closed near 3rd Ave. W. (area shown in red) from Jan. 19 to Jan. 20.
- Pedestrians and cyclists detour to W. Ewing Alley or W. Nickerson Street
- Signs marking the trail closure
- W. Ewing St. remains closed to all traffic
- Asphalt trucks on and around the project site
- Odors from laying the asphalt will subside after paving is complete
- Work on weekdays from 7 a.m. – 6 p.m.
