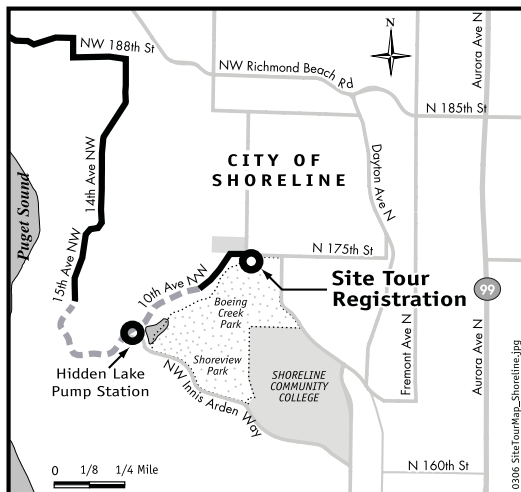

Hidden Lake Sewer Improvement Project

King County is upgrading and replacing aging wastewater facilities in Shoreline. We've completed design of a new 500,000 gallon underground storage pipe in Boeing Creek Park to help limit overflows to Puget Sound. Come learn more about the pipe, the new sewers in the streets near the park, and the Hidden Lake Pump Station. Construction is expected to begin in Spring 2006.
