

HIDDEN LAKE Sewer Improvement Project

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Notice to Residents Construction Activities in Boeing Creek Park begin Week of July 17, 2006

As part of the Hidden Lake Sewer Improvement Project, an underground storage pipe and odor control facility will be installed in Boeing Creek Park. The underground pipe will temporarily store wastewater during large storms, helping to limit overflows to Puget Sound.

Frank Coluccio Construction Company is the contractor hired by King County to construct the project. The contractor will install erosion control fencing and prepare the work area beginning the week of July 17. Major construction activities will begin soon afterward and continue for approximately a year.

What should you expect?

- Access to Boeing Creek Park will be maintained. For your safety, follow traffic control and trail detour signs and keep dogs on leash.
- Construction noise and activity will occur weekdays between 7 a.m. and 7 p.m. weekdays, and possibly some Saturdays.
- Trucks and large equipment will be in the area. Intermittent lane closures and parking disruption may occur. When you visit the park, look for traffic signs and flaggers directing traffic. Use extra caution.
- There will be no closure of 10th Ave NW until spring 2007.
- The contractor will reseed the site when construction is complete. The City of Shoreline plans further improvements for Boeing Creek Park.
