Juanita Bay Pump Station Replacement Project CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

New Juanita Bay Pump Station now operating!

King County's contractor for the Juanita Bay Pump Station project has completed the final force main tie-in to the new pump station. This service connection shifts wastewater conveyance fully to the new pump station. The smaller pump station to the west is now out of service.

The major portion of the pump station project is now complete. Some minor utility work at the southwest corner of Juanita Drive Northeast and 93rd Avenue Northeast intersection will occur this week. Backfilling near the intersection and some additional manhole work will be complete in the next week. The contractor is demobilizing the staging area and the construction trailers will be removed from the Juanita Beach Park site in the next 10 days. Areas affected by the project will be restored. Additional painting, landscaping, sidewalk work and any minor corrective work on the interior will continue through March.

Project completion is now very close. Please report any remaining questions by January 31:

Connecting the new pump station to the existing wastewater system brings the project very close to completion. King County and its project team deeply appreciate your patience during construction and want to address any remaining construction-related issues prior to the project's completion.
