

# Juanita Bay Pump Station Replacement Project CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

September 2005

### Construction begins in September 2005

To ensure safe and reliable operations and provide wastewater capacity for the future, the King County Wastewater Treatment Division is replacing the Juanita Bay Pump Station in Kirkland.

#### What should you expect this fall?

- Construction activity will generally take place weekdays between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m.
- Signs and flaggers will direct and control traffic safely through the work area.
- This fall, the contractor will:
  - Bring equipment and materials to the pump station site and staging area
  - Place rock and install a fence around the construction staging area in the park
  - Drill and install sound walls on two sides of the pump station site, close to condos and apartments
  - Install underground utilities (water and storm sewer pipes) under 93<sup>rd</sup> Avenue N.E.
  - Begin drilling secant piles for the pump station foundation

## What will be done to minimize community impacts?

- The pump station site and construction staging area will be fenced.
- Sound walls will be built on two sides of the pump station site, near adjacent apartments and condos.
- Access to residences and Juanita Beach Park will be provided at all times.
- County staff will be available 24 hours a day to respond to questions and concerns.
