



King County's KIRKLAND PUMP STATION and SEWER UPGRADE PROJECT

December 20, 2011

Minor delays at Intersection of Kirkland Ave. and Sixth St. due to traffic revisions Sewer Construction will require traffic to be reduced to one lane Dec. 21 and 22

On December 21st and 22nd, sewer pipeline construction will require two days of traffic revisions at the intersection of Kirkland Avenue and Sixth Street. Residents should plan for minor delays when navigating this intersection. In order to safely and efficiently complete this work, traffic will be reduced to one lane with flaggers assisting vehicles through the intersection. The traffic revision will be in place during work hours, from 7 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

What to expect

- Crews will maintain one lane; flaggers will assist vehicles alternating through the intersection.
- Signed detours and flaggers will assist drivers and pedestrians through the area.
- Parking restrictions will be in place near the proposed work locations.
- Work December 21 and 22, from 7:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m.
- Noise and other activity typical of a construction site: work crews, dust, trucks, construction materials, heavy machinery, and excavation equipment.
- Excavation of an approximately seven-foot-deep trench in Kirkland Avenue to lay a new 16-inch pipe.
