Starting August 19 – Utility Vault Work on Kirkland Avenue Closes Sidewalk

Starting August 19, a contractor working for King County Wastewater Treatment Division will work in an underground vault beneath the sidewalk near 811 Kirkland Avenue. During this work, the sidewalk on the south side of Kirkland Avenue will be closed around-the-clock in front of the Kirkland Avenue Office Park (see map).

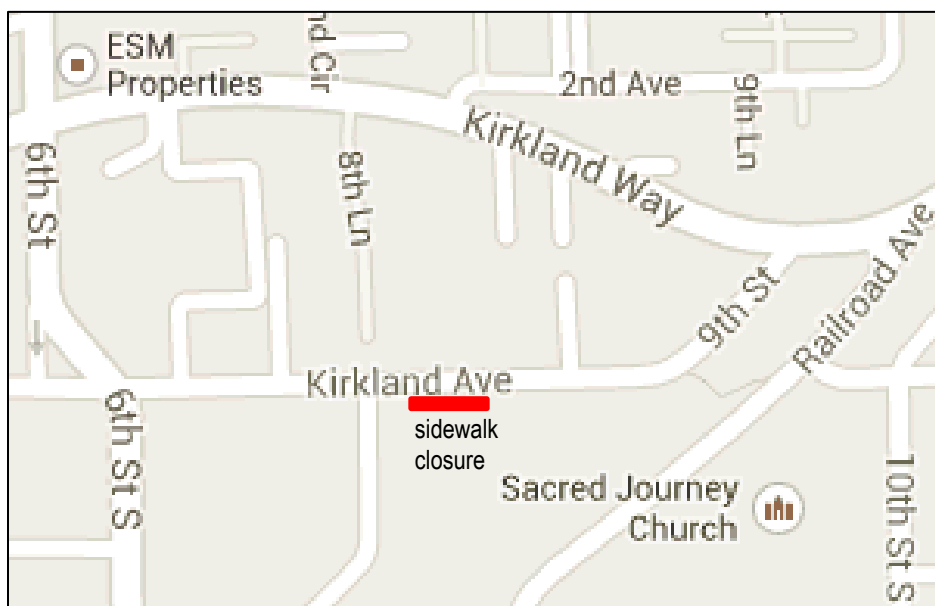
- This work will take approximately 2 weeks to complete.
- Work hours are Monday through Thursday, 7:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., but the sidewalk will be closed around the clock.
- Kirkland Avenue will be reduced to one lane during work hours, but will remain open to through traffic. Flaggers and traffic signage will be in place to assist drivers.
- Access will be maintained to businesses and residences.

What to expect

- On-street parking restrictions will be in place at the work locations.
- Traffic control signs will narrow lanes on Kirkland Avenue; traffic will be maintained through the work zone.
- Noise and other activity typical of construction: work crews, trucks, excavating equipment.
