# Murray Combined Sewer Overflow Control Facility Design Meeting

King County is building an underground storage tank and support equipment across from Lowman Beach Park to store excess stormwater and wastewater flows during storms. The facility will protect public health and clean up Puget Sound by reducing the discharge of these excess flows— known as combined sewer overflows (CSOs) – to Puget Sound.

- share your views and values to help inform facility design
- learn how the facility will safely and reliably protect public health and the environment
- work in small groups with the project team to brainstorm ways to make a facility an asset to the community.
