

Project Update

New water pipe to be installed under Beach Drive S.W. in early July

King County contractors for the Murray CSO Control project will begin replacing an eight-inch water pipe in Beach Drive S.W. this week. The work requires excavators, trucks, and a crane to work in Beach Drive S.W. for about a month.

The work will create traffic congestion and delays, especially south of the Lincoln Park Way S.W. intersection on Beach Dr. S.W. Flaggers will guide traffic around the work site. Emergency and local access on Beach Dr. S.W. will be maintained. All parking will be closed along Beach Drive S.W. south of the Lincoln Park Way S.W. Steel plates will cover the work area in the road outside of work hours. The road will be patched after the pipe is installed and fully restored at the end of the project.

Installing the new pipe will <u>not</u> affect water service to neighbors. Connecting the new pipe <u>will require a service</u> <u>outage</u> later this summer for Beach Drive S.W. residents south of the Lincoln Park Way intersection. More information will be provided before that work occurs.

Crews will continue building the underground storage tank while the water pipe installation occurs

What to expect:

- Work hours between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.
- Crews working in the center of Beach Drive S.W. and inside the underground storage tank
- Single lane access on Beach Drive S.W. south of the Lincoln Park Way intersection
- Increased truck traffic, congestion and traffic delays
- No parking on the 7000 block of Beach Drive S.W.
- Flaggers directing traffic along Beach Dr. S.W. at the Lincoln Park Way S.W. intersection
- East sidewalk of Beach Dr. S.W. closed between 7 a.m. and 6 p.m.
