## Construction activities on 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West

**April 29 – May 7, 2015**

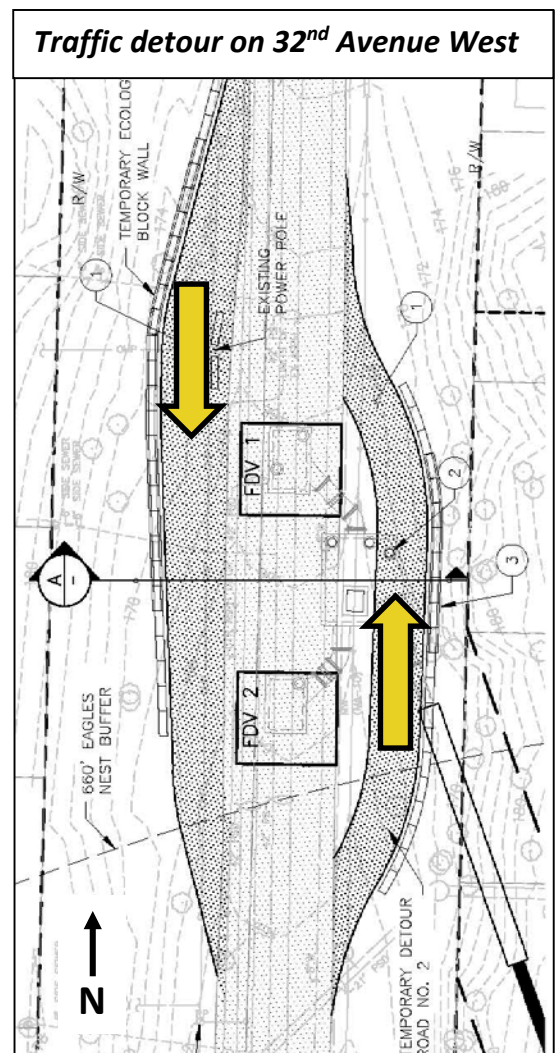
King County's contractor, Walsh Construction, is installing an underground structure on 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West that will transfer wastewater from the existing sewer line to the new gravity sewer pipeline. The new 3,000-foot sewer line is one part of a new combined sewer overflow (CSO) control facility in Magnolia that will reduce overflows of stormwater and sewage to Puget Sound during heavy rain storms.

- **This week, you can expect short traffic delays as crews set up temporary traffic detours.** Flaggers will direct southbound traffic to the west side of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West and northbound traffic to the east side of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West.
- Traffic detours are necessary for crews to connect pipes to a pump along the west side of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West near the Howe Street Bridge to complete a bypass for sewer flows around the work area.
- Crews will also begin installing shoring and support for the flow diversion structure in the middle of 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West.

### What you can expect during this work

- Work hours 7:00 a.m. to about 5:00 p.m. Monday -- Friday.
- Expect limited construction noise and a quiet generator that is no louder than the one that has been in place throughout the project.
- The work area will be fenced at night, and the detour will remain in place.

**Please drive slowly in the work area and watch for signs and flaggers**



**As a reminder, do not park along the eastern corner 32<sup>nd</sup> Avenue West and West Galer Street.** The corner serves as a critical catch basin for stormwater runoff. The contractor has marked the area off as a no parking zone, but continued parking in that area has resulted in damage to erosion control measures. The presence of a fire hydrant at the corner also prohibits parking within 15 feet, per Seattle Municipal Code.
