Restoration in West Galer Street work area during the week of June 5

Work continues on a plan for the pipe

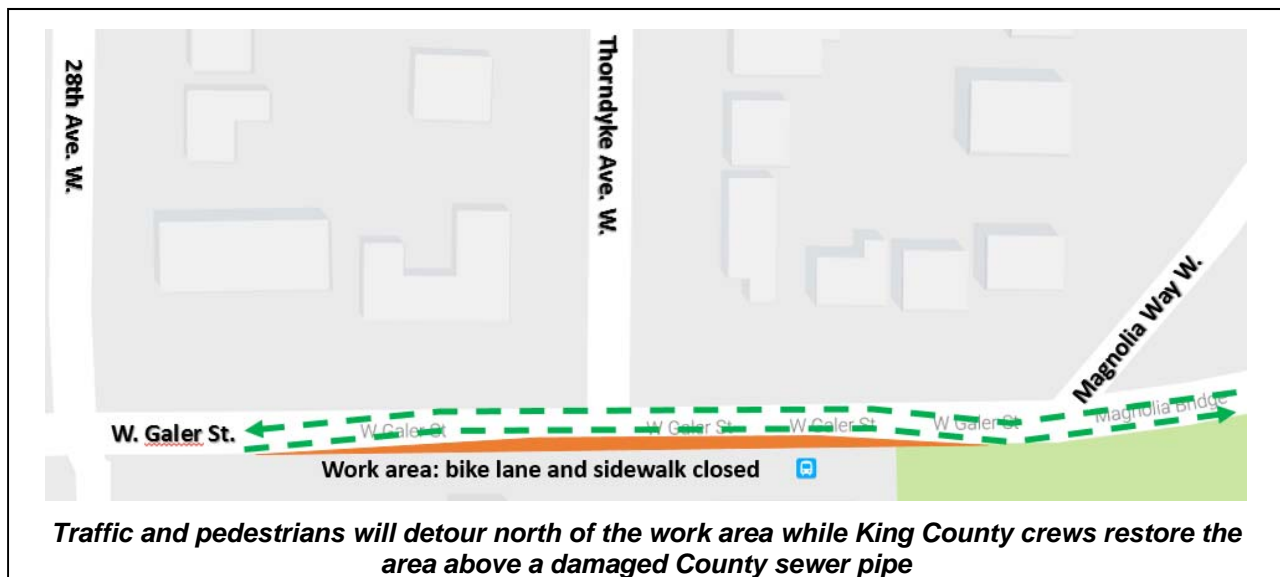
Good news! The drilling and grouting along West Galer Street is complete. King County's contractor will restore the work area near Thorndyke Avenue West during the week of June 5. We expect to finish work by the end of the week.

The restoration work includes:

- Repairs to sidewalks and any impacted driveways
- Replanting landscaping and planter strips

What to expect:

- Project work, crews, equipment and detoured traffic patterns near the intersection of W. Galer St. and Thorndyke Ave. W. starting June 7
- Work is expected to finish by the end of the week
- **STAY SAFE!** Traffic and pedestrians should detour north of the work area – traffic control personnel will be on site to ensure safe passage around the work area
- Work on weekdays from 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.



Next Steps

King County and its contractor continue work on a plan to bring the pipe into service.

We will share the plan with you before starting work.
