Phase B of the Kent-Auburn Conveyance System Improvements Project

Construction Update - October 13, 2017

Preparation for installing the new sewer line continues along Seattle Boulevard South

King County's contractor has been working along Seattle Boulevard South in Algona to prepare for building a new sewer line under the road. They are completing the following activities:

- Surveying
- 'Potholing' to locate utilities
- Installing monitoring equipment

As soon as next week, you may also see crews installing dewatering wells, pipes and tanks (see photo).

Actual pipe construction is expected to begin mid-November. We will notify you before pipe installation begins.

What is dewatering?

Dewatering removes underground water from the work area. Removing this water is an important step to allow below-ground construction.

What to expect during work

- Work hours are weekdays 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Saturdays
- Dewatering equipment will stay in place until construction is done
- There may be temporary traffic detours; flaggers will direct people
- You may hear noise from pumps; these run around the clock during construction
- Dewatering needs to start several weeks before crews install the new sewer line;
