

## Construction Update – November 15, 2017

## Crews begin to install new sewer line on Seattle Boulevard South

Crews are beginning to install the new sewer line along Seattle Boulevard South. Work will move south to north along the roadway.

This work is dependent on weather conditions. Crews will work until the rains are too heavy, then they will pause and resume work in the spring.

## What to expect during work

- Work hours (Algona): Monday-Friday from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Work hours (Pacific): Monday-Saturday 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Crews will not work over the Thanksgiving holiday (November 23-26)
- Open trenches will be covered outside of work hours
- Crews will close one block at a time; flaggers will direct traffic around construction
- Local access will be provided to homes, and for mail delivery and other services (emergency responders, deliveries, garbage pickup, etc.)
- Construction noise and vibration within allowable limits
- Dewatering equipment will stay in place until construction in the area is complete
